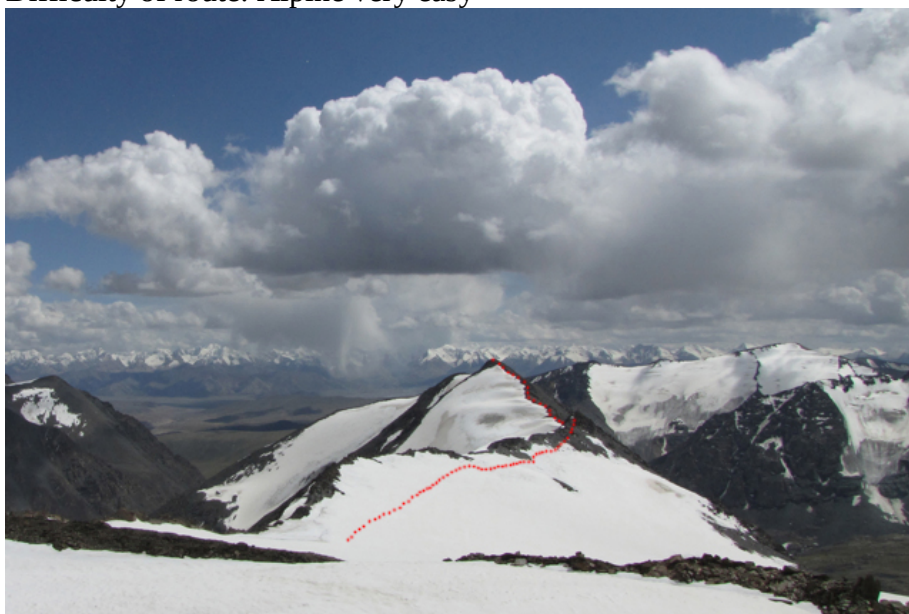

1) The unclimbed peak and the route we used

Elevation: 4350m

Difficulty of route: Alpine very easy



Henrik Olsen and Laurent Baraquin ascent the peak on the 29th July 2011.

We want to call this peak Mount 'Lou-Ann' in memory of my 3year old little cousine who died last year.

2) A new Solo-route opened by Baraquin Laurent.
